## CONSTITUTION OF KBH ARCHERS

### ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is KBH Archers.

### ARTICLE II,

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

### ARTICLE III,

The name of the Registered Agent of the corporation is Margaret Krause. The Post Office box number which may be used in conjunction with the Registered Agent's address is P.O. Box 245, Port Orchard, WA 98366-0245. The street address of the Registered Agent is 3124 Harold Drive S.E., Port Orchard, WA 98366.

### ARTICLE IV,

Purposes and Powers, The purposes and powers of the corporation are as follows:

- A. To perpetuate, foster and promote the practice of archery by setting a high standard of good fellowship, sportsmanship, hunting practice and conduct in the field.
- B. To maintain a course approved by NFAA for field shooting and insofar as possible similar to hunting conditions.
- C. To adopt, interpret and teach the rules and ethics of all forms of archery shooting, including bowhunting.
- D. To encourage membership in organized archery.
- E. To provide various types of archery rounds at club and invitational shoots.
- F. To present ideas for conservation, propagation of game and wildlife, better hunting conditions and laws through channels to the proper authorities.
- G. To operate and maintain archery and related archery club facilities.
- H. In general, and subject to such limitations and conditions as are or may be prescribed by law, or in the corporations Articles of Incorporation of By-Laws, the corporation shall have all powers which now or are hereafter conferred by law upon a corporation organized for the purposes hereinabove set forth, or necessary or incidental to the powers so conferred, or conducive to the attainment of the purposes of the corporation.

### ARTICLE V,

This corporation will have a membership, the classifications, qualifications, rights and responsibilities being set forth in the By-Laws of this non-profit corporation.

### ARTICLE VI,



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The management of the corporation will be vested in a board of no less than seven directors. The terms "directors", "trustees" and "governors" as those terms have been used by this organization, mean the same thing. The number, qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meetings, and powers and duties of directors shall be such as are prescribed by the By-Laws of the corporation.

## ARTICLE VII,

The authority to make, alter, amend or repeal the By-Laws is vested in the Board of Directors, provided that the voting membership is notified and has the opportunity to petition the board to require the changes to be voted on by the voting membership. With no petition the changes may be voted upon at any regular or special meeting of that board.

## ARTICLE VIII,

Upon dissolution, after all financial obligations have been satisfied in full, all assets shall be distributed equally to the Washington State Archery Association, National Field Archery Association, National Archery Association JOAD Program, and Washington State Bowhunters.
